- **Where is the HackFest?**

In the STMicroelectronics building at Via Remo De Feo 1, Arzano (NA) in the Arzano-Casoria-Frattamaggiore (ACF) industrial area. Park your car just before the security gate.

- **What are the hours?**

The HackFest starts at 09hr each morning. On Saturday it ends at 18hr and on Sunday at 15hr.

- **The HackFest is for “experts”. Am I an “expert”?**

If you have used any microcontroller and have a good knowledge of C, then you are an “expert”.

- **Is there WIFI?**

- **How is the HackFest organized?**

There will be three collaborative challenges:

- 1) Bring your application / idea and get it to run on the STM32 Nucleo.
- 2) Add an expansion board x-Nucleo or “shield” from those that will be available.
- 3) (secret challenge).

- **Can I bring my own components, or shields?**

- **What if I don't have an application or idea or SW tools? I'm a bit worried.**

- **Do I need to be in a team?**
